Round Up of Last Week's Games

The Lady Panthers had two match ups last week. On Tuesday they hosted Clay High School at Panther Stadium. In the junior varsity game, Clay were the first to get on the scoreboard six minutes into the game when one of their forwards broke through the defense at the half way line. **Amaya Austin** gave chase and keeper, **Madison Yonash**, came out, but the Blue Devil forward managed to squeeze off a shot and score. The Panthers responded quickly. Less than a minute later, **Malia Hofstra** took the ball down the right wing and crossed the ball in front of the opposition goal.

Jacqueline Gagliano was there to take a shot. The Clay keeper blocked her initial shot but

The Panthers scored again twenty minutes later when **Casey Miller** took advantage of a goalmouth scramble and slotted the ball into the net. The first half ended 2 – 1. The second half continued in a scrappy vein. Ridgeview pressured Clay but were unable to score. Clay equalized twelve minutes into the half when they were awarded a corner and scored in the resulting goalmouth scramble. The Panthers pushed hard for the remainder of the game but were unable to finish past a dogged Blue Devil defense. The game ended tied at 2 – 2.

The Panthers got off to a poor start in the varsity game. The game was only two minutes old when Clay High School

was awarded a corner. Clay number 6, their target player for corners, was left unmarked and scored with an unchallenged header. Clay went two up eight minutes later when their number 8 carried the ball into the box and skillfully went around several defenders to score. The Panthers reorganized at the water break and **Isabella Calalang-Boyer** was given the task of man marking the Blue Devils problematic number 8. Ridgeview were then able to put some pressure on the opposition. Twenty five minutes into the half **Kayla Alexander** passed to **Autumn Woodard** who made a run on goal from the half to score past the Clay keeper. The first half

ended 1 – 2. The second half continued with **Isabella Calalang-Boyer** on the Clay number 8 like a tight sweater. The created multiple chances but failed to finish and the first half ended a goalless draw. At half time **Madison Yonash** switched out with **Allison Dailey** in goal. The Panther back four of **Anna Magruder**, **Amaya Austin**, **Jasmine Echevarria** and **Melynna Gray** continued to shut out the Yellow Jackets in the second half. The game ended 2 – 0.

The varsity were quick to take control of their game despite some sloppy passes. The game was only two minutes old when **Genevieve Olah** passed to **Autumn Woodard** at the half way line who sprinted to goal to score. Eighteen minutes later, **Kyleigh Reedy** sent **Autumn Woodard** on another
