Round Up of Last Week's Games

The Lady Panthers hosted Matanzas High School at home on Tuesday night. The junior varsity team quickly dominated their game. The Panthers took the lead five minutes into the game when **Amaya Austin** sent the ball through to **Jacqueline Gagliano** who scored with a shot into the lower corner of the goal. Three minutes later, **Jacqueline Gagliano** set off on a sprint through the middle of the field to score number two. The Panthers went three up, two minutes later, when **Shayla Hofstra** sent the ball through to her sister, **Malia Hofstra**, to finish. Four minutes later the Panthers scored again when **Julie Christos** pushed the ball through for **Casey Miller** to finish. **Jacqueline Gagliano** got her hat-trick for the evening with a pass from **Amaya Austin** in the dying seconds of the half. The first half ended 5 – 0. The Panthers remained in control in the second half. Two minutes into the half, **Julie Christos** crossed the ball in for **Abbigail Gardiner** to score. Seven minutes later, the Panthers were awarded a penalty after an infraction in the box. **Casey Miller** stepped up to score from the spot. The Pirates did get a consolation goal one minute later when a fast Pirate forward broke through the defense to run on the keeper. Six minutes into the game, **Anya Alecca** took a corner kick and sent the ball to **Autumn Woodard**, in the six yard box, who scored with a right foot shot. The Pirates responded two minutes later and sent a ball through to their speedy #7 who took off to equalize in a one on one against keeper, **Genevieve Olah**.
