 - MUST BE REGISTERED FOR RHS IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN SPORTS
- MUST CURRENTLY HAVE A MINIMUM GPA OF 2.0 OR HIGHER

 - AN ATHELTIC PHYSICAL **DATED AFTER MARCH 2017** INCLUDING ALL REQUIRED FORMS. **FREE PHYSICALS** AVAILABLE ON **APRIL 22nd** AT ORANGE PARK HIGH SCHOOL FROM **9:30 AM – 11:00 AM**
 - COMPLETED CHEERLEADER APPLICATION
 - SIGNED SOCIAL MEDIA CONTRACT
 - SIGNED RULES ACKNOWLEDGMENT PAGE
- MUST BE PRESENT FOR ALL DAYS OF TRYOUTS
- COMPLETED TEACHER EVALUATIONS SUBMITTED BY **MAY 26TH** VIA CLAY COUNTY SCHOOL MAIL OR EMAILED TO COACH RICHARDSON FROM ANOTHER CLAY COUNTY TEACHER'S EMAIL ADDRESS. **ALL EVALUATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY A CORE SUBJECT TEACHER. FOR EXAMPLE: ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, OR HISTORY. NO EVALUATION WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM AN ELECTIVE COURSE TEACHER.**
- STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A **PLAIN** WHITE SHIRT AND BLACK OR BLUE SHORTS (SPANDEX UNDERNEATH) ON THE DAY OF TRYOUTS
- STUDENTS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO NOT WEAR JEWELRY OR HAVE ACRYLIC NAILS, GEL NAILS, OR GEL POLISHED NAILS THROUGHOUT THE TRYOUT PROCESS OR CHEER SEASON

***Tumbling will NOT be spotted at Clinic days or at Tryouts. The student must demonstrate tumbling skills they have on their own. Students will not be allowed to spot other student's tumbling.**

The tryout will be CLOSED to the public

There will be a **MANDATORY** parent meeting at **6:30 PM** in the RHS Cafeteria for all new members of the 2017 – 2018 JV and Varsity teams. **At least one parent or guardian per athlete MUST be present**

RIDGEVIEW HIGH SCHOOL CHEERLEADING RULES

PRACTICES/GAMES

- ALL PRACTICES, GAMES, AND PLAYOFFS ARE **MANDATORY**.
- CHEERLEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO ARRIVE **5-10** MINUTES **PRIOR** TO THE SCHEDULED PRACTICE TIME FULLY READY FOR PRACTICE.
- CHEERLEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO STAY THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF PRACTICE.
 - **LEAVING PRACTICE EARLY WILL BE EQUIVALENT TO BEING TARDY**
- **PRACTICE ATTIRE**
 - TEE SHIRT WITH SLEEVES, NIKE ATHLETIC SHORTS (SPANDEX UNDERNEATH), CHEERLEADING SHOES, HAIR UP, AND NO JEWELRY.
 - LEGGINGS CANNOT BE WORN AT ANYTIME.
 - CHEERLEADERS WHO ARE NOT DRESSED APPROPRIATELY WILL BE REQUIRED TO DO ADDITIONAL CONDITIONING WHILE AT PRACTICE.
 - ACRYLIC/GEL NAILS OR GEL POLISHED NAILS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME DURING THE SEASON
 - CHEERLEADERS MAY ONLY HAVE CLEAR OR FRENCH NAIL POLISH
 - IF ANY CHEERLEADER VIOLATES THESE RULES THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PRACTICE DUE TO FHSAA SAFETY REGULATIONS AND IT WILL COUNT AS AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE.
- ADDITIONAL PRACTICES WILL BE ADDED WHEN NEEDED WITH 24 HOUR NOTICE
 - EX: PEP RALLIES, HOMECOMING, COMPETITION
 - CHEERLEADERS THAT ARE NOT PRESENT FOR ALL "PEP RALLY PRACTICES" WILL NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE PEP RALLY ROUTINE.
- JV CHEERLEADERS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND ALL VARSITY HOME GAMES TO SHOW SUPPORT IN THE STUDENT SECTION.
- **CAMP & SUMMER PRACTICES**
 - CAMP IS **MANDATORY** FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE JV AND VARSITY TEAMS. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.
 - CHEERLEADERS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO MISS **THREE** SUMMER PRACTICES. CHEERLEADERS THAT MISS MORE THAN THREE PRACTICES DURING THE SUMMER WILL BE RELEASED FROM THE TEAM, UNLESS PREAPPROVED BY THE COACHING STAFF.

ATTENDANCE

- **THREE STRIKE POLICY**
 - CHEERLEADERS WHO ACCRUE THREE UNEXCUSED ABSENCES WILL BE RELEASED FROM THE TEAM.

- **TARDY POLICY**

- THREE TARDIES WILL BE EQUIVALENT TO ONE UNEXCUSED ABSENCE. CHEERLEADERS WHO ACCRUE **NINE** TARDIES WILL BE RELEASED FROM THE TEAM.
- UNEXCUSED TARDY EXAMPLES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:
 - OVERSLEPT, LACK OF SLEEP, CAR PROBLEMS, ALARM FAILED, PARENT’S FAULT, SIBLING’S FAULT, RIDE WAS LATE, TRAFFIC WAS BAD, RUNNING LATE, ETC.
- CHEERLEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE AT **ALL** GAMES AND PRACTICES.
- **JOBS, CLUB ACTIVITIES, EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES, DOCTOR’S APPOINTMENTS, ETC. MUST NOT INTERFERE WITH CHEERLEADING PRACTICES OR GAMES.*****
- IF YOU COMMIT TO CHEERLEADING, YOU ARE COMMITTING TO ATTEND EVERY PRACTICE, GAME, OR EVENT FROM **JUNE TO THE BEGINNING OF FEBRUARY! UNEXCUSED ABSENCES ARE THOSE CAUSED BY ANYTHING OTHER THAN ILLNESS OR FAMILY EMERGENCIES.**
- IN ADDITION, JUST BECAUSE A CHEERLEADER ASKS TO BE EXCUSED DOES NOT MEAN THE EXCUSE WILL BE GRANTED.
- IF YOU ARE ILL OR HAVE A FAMILY EMERGENCY, THE COACHES NEED TO BE NOTIFIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN IN ORDER FOR THE ABSENCE TO BE EXCUSED. PLEASE NOTIFY THE COACHES BEFORE THE ABSENCE OR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. ONLY UNDER EXTREME CIRCUMSTANCES WILL PRIOR NOTICE NOT BE ACCEPTED.

DOCTOR’S NOTES

- IN THE EVENT A CHEERLEADER HAS TO MISS A SCHEDULED CHEERLEADING EVENT OR CAN NOT PRACTICE DUE TO A MEDICAL REASON, A DOCTOR’S NOTE **MUST** BE PROVIDED.

UNIFORMS/POM POMS/MEGAPHONES

- UNIFORMS, POM POMS, AND MEGAPHONES WILL BE ISSUED THROUGH THE SCHOOL AND ARE PROPERTY OF THE RHS ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT.
- IF FOR ANY REASON A CHEERLEADER QUILTS OR IS DISMISSED, HE OR SHE IS EXPECTED TO RETURN ALL EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORMS WITHIN **5** DAYS OF BEING RELEASED FROM THE TEAM.
- CHEERLEADERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES APPROPRIATELY WHILE IN UNIFORM. VIOLATION WILL RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE TEAM.
- **IF FOR ANY REASON A CHEERLEADER DOES NOT RETURN OR LOSES A UNIFORM OR PIECE OF EQUIPMENT, HE/SHE IS FINANICALLY RESPONSIBLE AND WILL NEED TO PROVIDE THE FUNDS TO REPLACE THE UNIFORM OR EQUIPMENT THAT IS LOST*****

GRADES

- CHEERLEADERS ARE STUDENTS FIRST AND ATHLETES SECOND, YOU MUST MAINTAIN GOOD ACADEMIC STATUS.
- IF AT ANY TIME YOU ARE FAILING A CLASS, YOU ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND TUTORING. FAILURE TO ATTEND TUTORING WILL RESULT IN BENCHING.

- IN ORDER TO ENCOURAGE ACADEMIC SUCCESS ALL CHEERLEADERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND STUDY HALL ON PRACTICE DAYS. STUDY HALL WILL BE LOCATED IN COACH RICHARDSON'S AND COACH STUTZ'S CLASSROOMS. STUDENTS WHO ARE INVOLVED IN CLUBS, AFTER SCHOOL TUTORING, OR ANY RIDGEVIEW HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITY WILL BE EXCUSED WITH PRIOR NOTICE FROM THE FACULTY MEMBER IN CHARGE.

COMMUNICATION

- **EMAIL WILL BE THE PRIMARY SOURCE OF COMMUNICATION*****
- EACH COACH MUST BE PROVIDED WITH AN EMAIL ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER FOR AT LEAST ONE PARENT OR GUARDIAN AS WELL AS FOR THE CHEERLEADER.

ALL-STAR CHEERLEADING

- DUE TO SCHEDULING CONFLICTS, CHEERLEADERS THAT PARTICIPATE IN ALL-STAR CHEERLEADING WILL **NOT** BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE RIDGEVIEW HIGH SCHOOL CHEERLEADING VARSITY COMPETITION TEAM OR JV COMPETITION TEAM.

FUNDRAISING/DIRECT PAYMENTS

- **EVERY CHEERLEADER WILL BE REQUIRED TO FUNDRAISE THROUGHOUT THE SEASON.**
- **IF AT ANY TIME A CHEERLEADER QUILTS OR IS DISMISSED FROM THE TEAM, THEY WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND FROM ANY FUNDRAISERS OR DIRECT PAYMENTS.**

RIDGEVIEW HIGH SCHOOL VARSITY AND JV COMPETITION CHEERLEADING

The 2017-2018 Ridgeview High School Competition Cheerleading teams will be announced in October. Each athlete, on the JV and Varsity teams, will be constantly evaluated by the coaching staff from the first practice through the beginning of October. The team selection will be based on the needs of the routines and only the cheerleaders who have the required skills will be chosen.

Varsity Competition Team

Please be aware that the Ridgeview Varsity Cheerleading team plans to compete in the Large Coed division for FHSAA State and the Medium Coed division for UCA Nationals if the team receives a bid to compete at Nationals. The **TOP 25** cheerleaders will be selected. Therefore the team selection will be approximately as follows:

- **6-8 male cheerleaders**
- **6-7 female Coed flyers**
- **10-13 female cheerleaders that have most of if not all of following skills:**
 - **base, back-spot, elite standing tumbling, and elite running tumbling**

***If for any reason, a Varsity team member does not make the Varsity Competition team they will be automatically placed on the JV Nationals Competition team if the JV competition team's numbers does not exceed 25 members.**

JV Competition Team

Depending on the number of athletes on the JV team, the goal for the 2017-2018 season is for the JV team to compete. Please be aware that if your athlete is chosen for the JV sideline team that he/she will be automatically committed to the JV competition team. The JV competitive team will compete at local Head-to-Head competitions as well as the UCA Regional and UCA Nationals if a bid is received.

*****New female members to the Varsity and JV competition teams will be required to purchase a competition bodysuit that matches the uniform. The bodysuit will cost \$80.00 and will be due October 9th.**

*****Cheerleaders that do not make the competition team will remain sideline cheerleaders for both our Fall and Winter sports*****

UCA NATIONALS 2018

It is one of the goals for the 2017-2018 season to have both the Varsity and JV competition teams qualify and to compete at UCA Nationals. In order to make this goal a reality, every cheerleader will be required to fundraise throughout the season as well as paying for their entry to the competition. The amount would total **\$260.00** for each cheerleader which would be due **October 30th**. That said, the Cheerleading Account will pay for the hotel stay for both the JV and Varsity teams while we are at UCA Nationals.

The \$260.00 payment per cheerleader can be lowered by fundraising. All fundraising efforts this season will be going towards funding our regular season costs, competitive equipment, competition fees, and UCA Nationals hotel stay. If there is an excess of funds after all the aforementioned items have been paid for, that amount will go towards lowering the entry fee cost of \$260.00. The more we are able to fundraise the less you will have to pay for out of pocket!
